On June 7, 2010, respondent requested to be enrolled as an inactive member of the State Bar for eighty (80) days under Business and Professions Code section 6233.¹

Based upon respondent's request to be enrolled as an inactive member and her acceptance into the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program (ADP) on March 12, 2007, the court granted respondent's request.

Petitioner now seeks an order that will allow her to return to active membership status enrollment. Petitioner supports her petition with evidence that she has not engaged in the unauthorized practice of law since the beginning of her suspension on August 1, 2010, and that she has been in full compliance with requirements of her enrollment in the ADP.

The court having considered the petition and declarations finds good cause to grant the petition. The Court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that there is no longer a basis for petitioner's involuntary inactive enrollment pursuant to section 6233.

ACCORDINGLY, it is ordered that the petition for transfer to active membership status is **GRANTED**. It is further ordered that petitioner's inactive enrollment pursuant to section 6233 is hereby terminated and she shall be entitled to resume the practice of law in this state on October 20, 2010.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
