On April 28, 2014, respondent Scott Smith Furstman filed a motion for a second extension of his discipline probation in order to permit him to complete the restitution he owes.¹ The Office of Probation and the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar oppose the motion. Accordingly, respondent's probation in the above-numbered case is extended until April 29, 2015.²


