This matter is before the court on respondent COLIN JON KOOYUMJIAN'S May 14, 2008, motion for modification of probation due to inpatient drug treatment/request for financial relief. On May 29, 2008, the State Bar of California, Office of Probation ("OP") filed a response in part in opposition, and in part, non-opposition. On June 4, 2008, the State Bar of California, Office of the Chief Trial Counsel ("OCTC") filed a motion in opposition. Respondent is representing himself in this matter. The OP is represented by Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade. The OCTC is represented by Deputy Trial Counsel Susan I. Kagan.

After a careful review of the pleadings, the court **DENIES** respondent's motion for relief from disciplinary costs, as respondent has not offered any plan for repayment, and his request is premature.

The court also **DENIES** respondent's motion to modify his terms of probation requiring restitution. Respondent has failed to submit a proposal for a repayment plan.

The court **GRANTS** respondent's request to modify his terms of probation and accepts his in-patient recovery facility stay in October, November, and December 2007, in lieu of Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous meetings. Concerning his December 2007 in-patient



recovery facility stay , respondent will receive credit for attending 3 meetings.
