




Dear Judge Remke:

The Supreme Court in the above-entitled proceeding entered an Order filed October 31, 2007 requiring the respondent to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one (1) year of the effective date of the Supreme Court order.

On December 27, 2007 the Office of Probation mailed notice to the respondent at 43225 Whittier Ave, Hemet, CA 92544, which was his Membership Records address at that time, advising the respondent of the provisions of the Supreme Court Order. The envelope containing said notice was not returned to this office by the postal authorities.

This letter formally advises the State Bar Court that as of the date of this letter, the respondent has not filed with the Office of Probation proof of successful completion of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination.
