On November 3, 2011, respondent Louis G. Fazzi filed a motion for relief from or further extension of time to pay the outstanding disciplinary costs of \$865.00. With his motion, respondent filed a financial declaration. On November 28, 2011, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California, by Deputy Trial Counsel Michael J. Glass, filed a responsive pleading to the motion, indicating opposition to full relief, but agreement to an alternative payment plan.

The court finds no good cause to provide full relief from the outstanding disciplinary costs. However, the court does find good cause to extend the payment over three years. Therefore, respondent must make three equal annual installments of the total amount of outstanding disciplinary costs, on or before March 1, 2012, March 1, 2013, and March 1, 2014. The outstanding balance will be due if respondent defaults under the terms of the payment plan.


