**ORDERS:**

**Respondent's Motion for Relief from or Extension of Time to Pay Costs**

On November 16, 2011, Respondent filed a motion for relief from the Supreme Court's order assessing costs. On November 17, 2011, the State Bar filed its statement of non-opposition to the motion to extend the time to pay costs.

No Good Cause having been shown, Respondent's request to be relieved completely of the obligation to pay costs is DENIED.

GOOD CAUSE, however, has been shown for extending the time to pay such costs. Accordingly, the costs that remain outstanding will now be paid in equal installments over the three billing cycles beginning in 2013. More specifically, one-third of the disciplinary costs must be paid prior to February 1, 2013; one-third of the costs must be paid prior to February 1, 2014; and one-third of the costs must be paid prior to February 1, 2015. If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar or a further order of this court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs will be due immediately and be enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


