

Since respondent **Robert W. Wiley, State Bar Number 64883**, has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 311.11, subdivision (a), a felony, under the authority of rule California Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a) it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective May 11, 2009, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

Respondent has ten days after service of this order to file a response to the State Bar's motion requesting that we classify respondent's conviction as a crime involving moral turpitude.


