On July 6, 2010, the parties submitted a stipulation as to facts, conclusions of law, and disposition in this matter. In the stipulation, the State Bar estimated that the disciplinary costs associated with the matter were \$39.17. The stipulation was approved and filed by this court on July 21, 2010.


On July 28, 2010, the State Bar filed a Notice of Error in Stipulation. In that notice, it indicated that the "accurate estimate" of the disciplinary costs is \$21,172.00. No reason was given in the notice as to why there was such a substantial variance between the two estimates.

In its Notice, the State Bar requested that the stipulation be modified to reflect the new cost estimate. No objection to the request has been filed by Respondent. Accordingly, the Stipulation is deemed modified to reflect the new cost estimate.

Any objection to the stipulation, as now further modified, must be filed within 15 days after the service of this order by mail. If either party timely files an objection, the stipulation is deemed rejected and the order of involuntary inactive enrollment will be deemed vacated on the date the objection is filed without the necessity of further court order. If no timely objection is filed, the stipulation, as modified, remains approved, and the prior order of involuntary inactive enrollment will remain effective.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


