

Since respondent Mel Wayne Campbell, State Bar Number 158764, has been convicted of one count of violating Penal Code section 496, subdivision (a) (receiving stolen property) and three counts of violating Penal Code section 186.10, subdivision (a)(money laundering), felonies involving moral turpitude, under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective October 15, 2010, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.


