

On December 14, 2012, respondent Razi Abbas Shah filed motions to (1) extend the time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE), (2) modify or terminate his disciplinary probation, (3) relieve him in whole or in part from the order assessing disciplinary costs,¹ and (4) remove his discipline record from the State Bar's website. The court finds good cause to extend the time to take and pass the MPRE and to extend the time to pay the costs. No good cause has been shown for the remaining requests.

Accordingly, the time to take and pass the MPRE and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles is extended until May 10, 2013. Further, the time to pay the disciplinary costs is extended so that one-fourth of the disciplinary costs must be paid with respondent's membership fees for each of the years 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017. The remaining requests in respondent's December 14, 2012, motions are denied.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
