19 **THE STATE BAR COURT TRIAL:**

- 20 (1) **YOUR DEFAULT WILL BE ENTERED;**
- 21 (2) **YOUR STATUS WILL BE CHANGED TO INACTIVE AND YOU**  
22 **WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PRACTICE LAW;**
- 23 (3) **YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE FURTHER IN**  
24 **THESE PROCEEDINGS UNLESS YOU MAKE A TIMELY MOTION**  
25 **AND THE DEFAULT IS SET ASIDE, AND;**
- 26 (4) **YOU SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL DISCIPLINE.**

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1 The State Bar of California alleges:

2 JURISDICTION

3 1. Daniel Duchanin ("Respondent") was admitted to the practice of law in the State of  
4 California on October 29, 1997, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges, and is  
5 currently a member of the State Bar of California.

6 COUNT ONE

7 Case No. 11-O-11508  
8 Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k)  
[Failure to Comply with Conditions of Probation]

9 2. Respondent willfully violated Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k), by  
10 failing to comply with all conditions attached to any disciplinary probation, as follows:

11 3. On or about March 11, 2010, the California Supreme Court filed Order No. S179480  
12 ("Disciplinary Order") regarding discipline of Respondent. On or about March 11, 2010, the  
13 Clerk of the Supreme Court of the State of California properly served a copy of the Disciplinary  
14 Order by mail on Respondent. Respondent received the Disciplinary Order.

15 4. On or about April 10, 2010, the Disciplinary Order became effective, thirty days after  
16 the Disciplinary Order was filed.

17 5. The Disciplinary Order placed Respondent on a two-year probation subject to certain  
18 conditions of probation. On or about April 26, 2010, a probation deputy of the Office of  
19 Probation mailed a letter to Respondent at his member records address reminding him of the  
20 conditions of probation. Respondent received the letter from the probation deputy.

21 6. On or about July 30, 2010, a probation deputy of the Office of Probation mailed a  
22 letter to Respondent at his member records address again reminding him of the conditions of  
23 probation and advising him that the Office of Probation had not received his first quarterly  
24 report. Respondent received the July 30, 2010 letter from the probation deputy.

25 7. As a condition of probation, Respondent was required to submit written quarterly  
26 reports to the Office of Probation on each January 10, April 10, July 10, and October 10 of the  
27 period of probation, stating under penalty of perjury his compliance with the State Bar Act, the  
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1 Rules of Professional Conduct, and all conditions of probation during the preceding calendar  
2 quarter.

3 8. Respondent did not submit to the Office of Probation a written quarterly report due by  
4 July 10, 2010, until September 7, 2010.

5 9. Respondent did not submit to the Office of Probation a written quarterly report due by  
6 January 10, 2011.

7 10. Respondent did not submit to the Office of Probation a written quarterly report due by  
8 October 10, 2010, until April 27, 2011. In addition, Respondent did not submit to the Office of  
9 Probation a written quarterly report due by April 10, 2011, until April 27, 2011.

10 11. As a condition of probation, Respondent was required to provide to the Office of  
11 Probation satisfactory proof of attendance at a session of Ethics School, and passage of the test  
12 given at the end of that session, within one (1) year of the effective date of the Discipline Order.  
13 Respondent did not provide the Office of Probation satisfactory proof of attendance at a session  
14 of Ethics School, and passage of the test given at the end of that session, by April 10, 2011.

15 12. By the foregoing, Respondent failed to comply with all conditions attached to any  
16 disciplinary probation.

17 **NOTICE - INACTIVE ENROLLMENT!**

25 **RECOMMENDED BY THE COURT.**

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


