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The State Bar of California alleges:

JURISDICTION

1. Kevin Michael White (“White”) was admitted to the practice of law in the State of California on June 1, 2000, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges, and is currently a member of the State Bar of California.

2. Kimberly Allyson Hansen (“Hansen”) was admitted to the practice of law in the State of California on December 10, 1993, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges, and is currently a member of the State Bar of California.

3. White and Hansen will be referred to herein collectively as “Respondents.”

COUNT ONE

Case Nos. 11-O-17873; 11-O-17874  
Business and Professions Code, section 6068(d)  
[Seeking to Mislead a Judge]

4. Between about June 2009 and September 2010, while representing defendants in a workers’ compensation matter, *Louis Speight v. Vulcan Materials, et al.*, Case No. ADJ6551691, Respondents represented to the court that although defendants had repeatedly requested a qualified medical evaluator panel to the Medical Director of the Division of Workers’ Compensation, such requests were ignored, when, in fact, defendants’ first two requests were denied in writing for being defective and their final request was granted. Respondents knew their representations to the court were false, and thereby sought to mislead the judge or judicial officer by an artifice or false statement of fact or law, in willful violation of Business and Professions Code, section 6068(d).

COUNT TWO

Case Nos. 11-O-17873; 11-O-17874  
Business and Professions Code, section 6106  
[Misrepresentation]

5. Between about June 2009 and September 2010, while representing defendants in a workers’ compensation matter, *Louis Speight v. Vulcan Materials, et al.*, Case No. ADJ6551691, Respondents represented to the court that although defendants had repeatedly requested a

1 qualified medical evaluator panel to the Medical Director of the Division of Workers'  
2 Compensation, such requests were ignored, when, in fact, defendants' first two requests were  
3 denied in writing for being defective and their final request was granted. Respondents knew or  
4 were grossly negligent in not knowing that their representations to the court were false, and  
5 thereby committed an act involving moral turpitude, dishonesty or corruption in willful violation  
6 of Business and Professions Code, section 6106.
