

Dear Judge Remke:

The Supreme Court in the above-entitled proceeding entered an Order filed February 14, 2013, requiring the respondent to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year of the effective date of the Supreme Court Order by **March 16, 2014**.

On March 25, 2013, the Office of Probation mailed a notice to respondent at: 12525 Havelock Ave., Los Angeles, CA 90066, which was his Membership Records address at that time, to remind respondent of the provisions of the Supreme Court Order. The envelope containing said notice was not returned to the Office of Probation by the postal authorities.

On September 5, 2013, the Office of Probation mailed a second notice to respondent at: D226, 12610 Braddock Dr., Los Angeles, CA 90066, which was his Membership Records address at that time. The envelope containing said notice was not returned to the Office of Probation by the postal authorities. Additionally, on the same date, the Office of Probation sent an e-mail to respondent with courtesy copies of its letters dated March 25, 2013 and September 5, 2013.

This letter formally advises the State Bar Court that as of the date of this letter, the respondent has **NOT** filed proof of successful completion of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination with the Office of Probation. Therefore, this matter is being referred for an order of indefinite suspension until the respondent provides the Office of Probation with proof of passage of the examination pursuant to rule 9.10(b), and *Segretti v. State Bar* (1976) 15 Cal.3d 878, 891.
