4 of California on December 17, 2003, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges, and is  
5 currently a member of the State Bar of California.

6 COUNT ONE

7 Case No. 14-H-04076  
8 Rules of Professional Conduct, Rule 1-110  
9 [Failure to Comply with Repeval Conditions]

10 2. Respondent willfully violated Rules of Professional Conduct, rule 1-110, by failing to  
11 comply with conditions attached to respondent's public reprovail in State Bar Case Number 12-  
12 C-15307, as follows:

13 A) Failing to timely cause a licensed medical laboratory to provide to the Office of  
14 Probation screening reports containing an analysis of respondent's blood and/or urine  
15 that were due on or before the tenth day of the following months:

- 16 i. July 2013;
- 17 ii. August 2013;
- 18 iii. November 2013;
- 19 iv. December 2013;
- 20 v. January 2014;
- 21 vi. February 2014;
- 22 vii. March 2014;
- 23 viii. April 2014;
- 24 ix. May 2014; and
- 25 x. June 2014;

26 B) Failing to timely submit to the Office of Probation a Quarterly Report that was due on  
27 January 10, 2014;

28 C) Failing to timely provide to the Office of Probation proof of attendance at two  
meetings of an abstinence-based self-help group during the month of April 2014.

1 D) Failing to provide to the Office of Probation proof of attendance at two meetings per  
2 month of an abstinence-based self-help group during the following months:

3 i. May 2014; and

4 ii. June 2014;

5 E) Failing to provide to the Office of Probation proof of attendance at a session of State  
6 Bar Ethics School, and passage of the test given at the end of that session, that was  
7 due on June 25, 2014; and

8 F) Failing to provide to the Office of Probation proof of passage of the Multistate  
9 Professional Responsibility Examination, administered by the National Conference of  
10 Bar Examiners, that was due on June 25, 2014.
